



UNIVERSITY OF ALBERTA SPORTS WALL OF FAME

It was recognized that the *University of Alberta Sports Wall of Fame* was specifically established to honour those Athletes and Builders who significantly contributed to the University of Alberta Sports Programs. Other City and Provincial Hall of Fames do exist and may honour those University Alumnus who have established outstanding achievements in activities outside of the University Programs.

1. SELECTION COMMITTEE

The Sports Wall of Fame Selection Committee is a sub-committee of the Sports Wall of Fame Committee.

A) Composition of the Selection Committee

3 Former Inductees Two Year Term
4 GGAS Representatives (1 Being the GGAS President)..... 3 for Three Years, President
1 Faculty of Physical Education & Recreation Representative Two Year Term
1 University Administration Representative..... Two Year Term

B) Nomination Procedures

- Where possible, gender equity should be considered
- Nominations for all members other than the Faculty and University Representatives will come from individual GGAS Alumni Groups and the current Selection Committee
- Faculty Representative should be appointed by the Faculty of Physical Education & Recreation Council
- University Representative should be appointed through the President's Office
- GGAS Representatives need not be standing members of the GGAS Executive
- Nominations shall be forwarded on request to the Board of Directors who shall then vote of the final selections
- Terms may be renewable

C) Chair of Selection Committee

- The Chair shall be selected from within the Selection Committee by the Selection Committee
- The Chair shall automatically be a member of the Sports Wall of Fame Dinner Organizing Committee

2. SPORTS WALL OF FAME INDUCTEE QUALIFICATIONS

A) Categories

Athlete

Priority shall be given to those former University of Alberta Athletes who established outstanding achievements while participating in the University of Alberta Athletic Programs.

Builder

Priority shall be given to those who directly contributed outstanding service to the University of Alberta Athletic Programs.

Exceptions

It is recognized that exceptions to the above principles may be considered for those other University of Alberta Alumnus who have established a record of outstanding achievement in Sport. For example, activities which are not included in the U of A Sports Programs.

B) Nomination Procedures

- Nominations will be solicited from the general public but should come primarily from the individual GGAS Alumni Groups
- Nominations will go through the GGAS Board of Directors to the Selection Committee
- Athletes should not be nominated while still actively participating
- Builders should not be nominated while still actively involved in University of Alberta Sports Programs
- Nomination lists shall regularly be made available to GGAS Alumni Groups

C) Selection of Inductees

- Selections are the sole responsibility of the Selection Committee who will provide the decision to the GGAS Executive for information
- A maximum of five inductees should normally be selected on an annual basis
- All other criteria, being equal selections, should be made from designated areas
